To organize seminars, workshops, conferences, awareness campaigns, exhibitions, community outreach programmes, educational events and training programmes for promoting education, health, environment, social welfare and sustainable development.

To undertake research, surveys, documentation, publications, knowledge dissemination and development of educational and informational materials relating to education, healthcare, environment, science, technology, social welfare and sustainable development.

To promote preservation and development of Indian art, culture, heritage, literature, languages, handicrafts, folk traditions, music, dance, yoga, sports, physical education and cultural values.

To promote digital inclusion, financial literacy, legal awareness, consumer awareness, road safety awareness, disaster preparedness, civic responsibility and public awareness through lawful charitable activities.

To collaborate with Government authorities, local bodies, educational institutions, healthcare institutions, charitable organizations, corporate entities and other lawful institutions for implementing charitable programmes.

To receive grants, donations, contributions, subscriptions, gifts, endowments and other lawful assistance solely for carrying out the charitable

objects of the Company.
To undertake all lawful charitable activities incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects in accordance with Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013.

To undertake research, surveys, documentation, publications, data collection and dissemination of knowledge for charitable and public welfare purposes.
To prepare, publish, print, translate and distribute educational, scientific, cultural and awareness material in physical or digital form for public benefit.
To establish, maintain and support health awareness centres, wellness centres, counselling centres, rehabilitation support programmes and preventive healthcare initiatives in accordance with applicable laws.
To undertake programmes for conservation of natural resources, afforestation, biodiversity protection, water conservation, waste management, renewable energy awareness and environmental sustainability.
To promote science, technology, innovation, digital literacy, financial literacy, legal literacy, consumer awareness and responsible use of technology through educational and

awareness programmes.

To promote Indian art, culture, literature, heritage, handicrafts, folk traditions, music, dance, yoga, sports and physical education for preservation and public awareness.

To undertake programmes for women empowerment, child welfare, youth development, senior citizen welfare, disability inclusion, livelihood enhancement and community development through education, training and awareness.

To establish and maintain community centres, skill development centres, counselling facilities, public utility centres and other charitable infrastructure required for achieving the objects of the Company.

To promote nutrition, hygiene, sanitation, safe drinking water, public health awareness and healthy lifestyle practices through charitable programmes.

To undertake disaster preparedness, relief support, rehabilitation and community recovery programmes in accordance with applicable laws.

To collaborate with Government authorities, local bodies, educational institutions, healthcare institutions, research organisations, charitable institutions, corporate entities and other lawful organisations for implementation of charitable projects.

To receive grants, donations, gifts, subscriptions, endowments, contributions, CSR assistance and other lawful support solely for carrying out the charitable objects of the Company.

To acquire, establish, maintain, manage, lease or otherwise use movable and immovable properties, equipment, vehicles, libraries, laboratories, training facilities and other infrastructure required for the charitable activities of the Company.

To establish and maintain old age support programmes, child development programmes, community welfare initiatives and public benefit facilities in accordance with applicable laws.

To promote volunteerism, leadership development, civic participation and community service through lawful charitable activities.

To undertake activities for protection of animals, birds and biodiversity, including awareness, welfare and conservation programmes in accordance with applicable laws.

To develop educational and awareness content through print, electronic and digital media for the advancement of the charitable objects of the Company.

To do all such lawful acts, deeds and things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, provided that the Company shall carry on its activities solely on a not-for-profit basis in accordance with Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudence remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company
